SACRED HEALING MEDITATION

Wednesday evenings, 6:40 pm

The Sacred Healing Meditation is a powerful spiritual experience of unconditional love. It is based on the premise that God and life are good and we are all holy and whole. The process involves a facilitator interacting with a person who lies fully-clothed on a massage table. The facilitator utilizes touch or near-touch on various parts of the receptive's body to open their energy to the healing power of Divine love.

Various facilitators trained in Sacred Meditation by Rev. Scott Sherman offer the process each Wednesday evening immediately following the Healing Prayer Service. The Meditation takes about 40 minutes to complete. It promotes well-being via relaxation and stress reduction, but is not a substitute for medical attention.

A session can be reserved by signing up on the lobby bulletin board across from the member mailboxes. We find that it can be beneficial to sit with us and share in the energy even if there is not adequate space to



be on a table. There is no charge for a session; however, love offerings to the church are accepted.

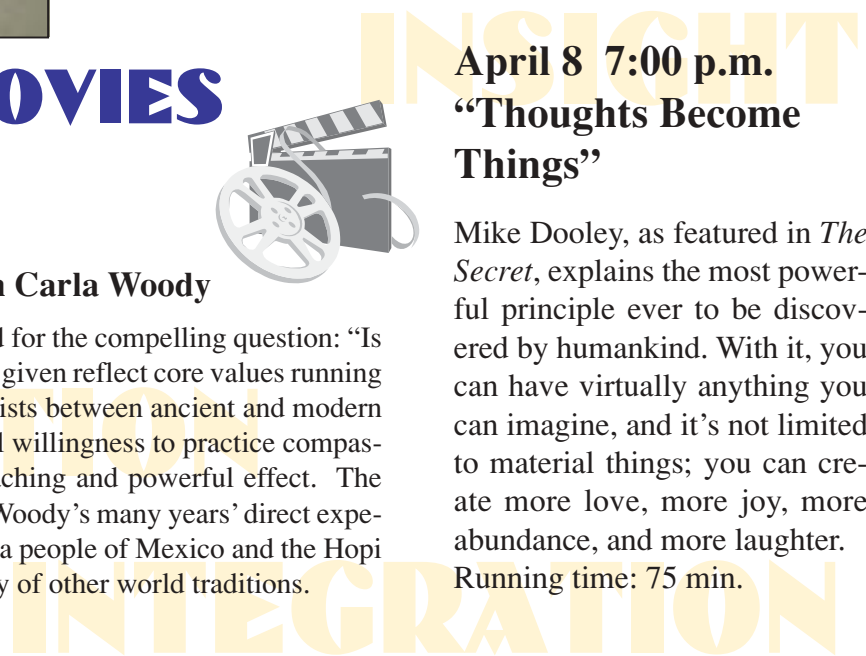

March is National Nutrition Month. In 2010 the USDA released new dietary guidelines. They provide science-based nutritional guidance for Americans ages 2 and older to promote healthy lifestyles and dietary habits. The guidelines recommend starting with these basics:

1. Fruits and vegetables contain essential vitamins, minerals, and fiber that may help protect you from chronic diseases.
2. Eat more whole grains, which contain heart-healthy fiber along with vitamins and minerals. Fiber can help you stay full between meals.
3. Replace vegetable oil with canola oil and olive oil, which are better for your heart.
4. Don't skip meals. And consider having smaller meals every three or four hours rather than bigger ones less often.


